Jessica Moffatt is a pastor, author, mediator and Spiritual Director. She has been a Methodist pastor for the last 38 years. Most recently, she served as the Senior Pastor of First United Methodist Church in Tulsa, Oklahoma since 2016. Prior to that position, she served as the Senior Pastor of First United Methodist Church in Ardmore, Oklahoma for 7 years. Before coming to Ardmore, she served for 12 years as the Senior Pastor of First United Methodist Church in Bixby, Oklahoma. Prior to coming to Bixby, she served for 12 years as the Executive Pastor, Minister of Community Ministries and Preaching Associate at First United Methodist Church in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Jessica Moffatt is the owner and CEO of The Tulsa Center for Reconciliation and Renewal where she now works as a Spiritual Director, Mediator and Discernmentarian.

Her additional area of expertise is in helping individuals, churches, committees and other groups make decisions following a discernment style of decision-making.

Jessica is a state-certified mediator in Georgia and Oklahoma. She has been trained by the Justice Center of Atlanta, Early Settlement in Tulsa and the Lombard Peace Center. For the last 25 years, she has helped churches and groups resolve conflict.

Jessica was appointed by the mayor of Tulsa to serve as a Commissioner on the Mayor's Commission on the Status of Women, organized to address issues of poverty, health and legislation for Tulsa women. She has been named as one of Ten Outstanding Young Tulsans.
