## Northern Illinois Purchasing Cooperative Buy American Exemption Form

<u>USDA Memo SP-38-2017</u> and <u>SP 23-2024</u> Compliance with and Enforcement of the Buy American Provision in the National School Lunch Program, requires school food authorities (SFAs) to purchase, to the maximum extent practicable, domestic commodity or product.
