

## 2021-22 SNA OF SC SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS



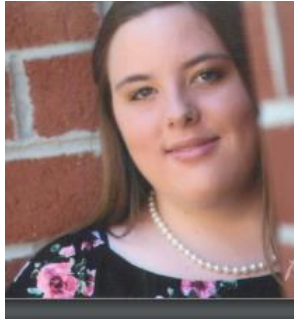

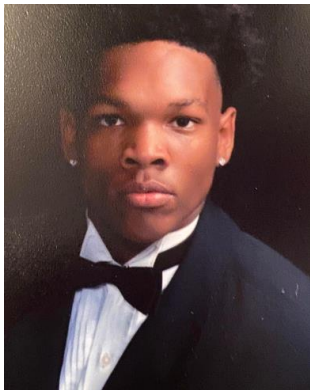
